What is Little Acorns?

Little Acorns is held on a Thursday afternoon from 1.15-2.45pm and is in addition to the kindergarten, child care, pre-school or kohanga reo that your child may already attend. It is a transition to school programme and aimed at children who are due to start school in the next ten weeks.

The parent / caregiver comes and stays for each session for the first five weeks. The next two weeks parents/caregivers drop and go. The last 3 sessions are on Wednesday morning from 8.45-10.30 when your child will visit the class they will be joining when they start school.

Who is this class for?

The class is for 4 year old children who will be starting school in the next term (10 weeks). If you make the decision to have your child join our Little Acorns, there needs to be an adult present for those first five weeks.
